Do's & Don'ts

to selling on Facebook

Try it - I highly recommend selling your unwanted/unused & unloved items on facebook in exchange for cash
(or getting a family member to help you)

When you are selling an item of any type - remember your buyer is looking for a bargain.

Be open to offers- and post it in the page - **ONO** (you certainly don't want to left with the item (s))

Smaller items you can meet them at your home or local Dunnes Stores carpark - I prefer to meet the buyer outside of my home

Larger items - remember buyers will be calling to your home and the majority of people are legit.

Get a mobile number always so you can contact them if you get delayed or need to change time or location.

Always meet your buyers (especcilly if your don't know them) during the day and in a busy location, le - Garage, playground or local shopping centre.

I always exchange details of what type of car I'm driving - colour/model & year and get the same from the other person.

Increase the selling price by between €10 -€20 so you taking in your "or nearest offer"

Don't over price and expect what you paid for the items first day.

Don't leave out photos & information - the more onformation you put in the post, the better chance you have of selling it.

Don't use your contact number on the ad for all to see - use Private messenger to swap contact details

Don't hold on to items for potential buyers, because they will forget and you will be left with it.

Don't entertain "TIME WASTERS"

Don't wait around if your buyers are a no show. I usually wait no more than 15 mins after time.

Don't leave items selling / free for weeks on end. Usually 7 - 10 days max.
if they don't sell, remove the ad and donate to charity asap.
